

General Information and Rules 2011

The Woodlands Cabana Club is a neighborhood co-op swim club whose membership is open to families living within the Valle Verde Elementary School boundaries, plus 100 memberships outside of these boundaries. The Club's swim team is open to the children of its members. For the 2011 swim season, the pool is open from May 7th to September 25th.

Annual Dues

Annual dues are \$520 payable in two installments- February, and March. All dues must be paid in full before commencement of the swimming season. A complete and correct Emergency Information form must also be completed and on file. Senior dues are \$260. This applies to a two-person household with one resident 62 or older.

Membership Initiation Fees

Membership initiation fees are \$400 payable in full, or \$200 per year for 2 years. Fully paid memberships are transferable (\$10 transfer fee) to the new property owner in the event a member sells their home. If membership lapses a reinstatement fee will be charged.

Finders Fee

Introduce a **new** member to the club and when they join, you will get a \$100 referral credit on your account. (This credit is applicable once per season per family)

Maintenance Levy

There is a \$100 per year maintenance levy. Members that work a minimum of 5 hours at the annual clean-up day will have a \$100 credit against the following year maintenance levy.

Guest Fees

Each member is allowed 20 free guest visits per year. After 20 guests, a \$2 per guest fee will be charged for each guest visit. Fees will be billed to the member's account and payable at the end of the swimming season. An adult member must accompany all guests.

Swim Lessons

Private swim lessons are available during the swimming season. Lessons consist of four 25-minute lessons. Prices are \$50 per session for members and \$80 per session for non-members.

Party Facilities

Safety and Pool Rules

Please become familiar with these important rules and regulations for the Club and have a safe and enjoyable swim season.

- Members and guests must sign in upon each visit to the Club
- **No floatation devices are allowed**
- Water toys such as swim fins, snorkels, water noodles and other toy type items may be used with permission from the Lifeguard on duty
- No diving in shallow, marked areas
- No running, pulling, pushing or horse play
- No bicycles, roller-skates, roller-blades, skateboards permitted in the pool or picnic areas
- Any child under the age of eight (8) must be accompanied by an adult
- Wading pool is for non-swimmers **only**
- No glass containers permitted
- No smoking permitted
- No animals, other than seeing-eye dogs, are allowed in the Club
- No profane or abusive language
- There will be a ten minute rest period every hour for swimmers under 18
- Only one person on the diving board at a time
- The middle pool is available for lap swimming instruction and one-to-one swimming instruction by either a Cabana Club instructor or a parent and one child **only** unless a guard is on duty at the middle pool. Children under age 13 may not swim laps **without** a supervising adult **in the water**
